General Provisions of the Exhibit Conditions

The Exhibit is held under the Slovak Breeders' Association Code on Exhibits. Animals eligible for the display are the ones born in the year 2016. Animals can be registered for the exhibit only by members of the Slovak Breeders Association and those foreign exhibitors whose associations are members of EE.

Applications for registration shall be made in writing (either postal or by email). Telephone registrations will not be accepted. Once animals have been listed in the catalogue, confirmation of application will be sent to the breeder.

During the exhibit, any manipulation of the animals by their proprietor, without the knowledge of the guarantor, is forbidden.

Competition Exhibits

RABBITS

- individually, no restrictions as to rabbits' gender
 - a 4-member collection in one colour
 - 4 siblings, no gender restriction
 - 2 + 2, no gender restriction
 - 2 siblings + 2 other individuals, no gender restriction
- / **K (Collection)** -has to be marked in the application /

Applications may be sent via the post office or by e-mail. The application deadline is Friday, October 21, 2016. Note that no applications will be considered or accepted after this date.

Exhibit Fees

- 2.50 € for each displayed animal
- 3.00 € for a catalogue, which is obligatory for all the exhibitors, including young breeders
- 100.00 € (an estimate) – 2 nights' accommodation in the same facility + supper (not compulsory)

Catalogues can be obtained only during the exhibit. After the exhibit is finished, sending the catalogues will not be possible.

If you like, you may support the event financially. Everybody who supports the exhibit by contributing money (from 5.00 €), or in a material way, will be listed in the catalogue as a sponsor of the exhibit.

Fees for cages and catalogues will be paid to Mr. Pieger on the spot, upon the acceptance of animals.

Veterinary Conditions

Only healthy animals can be accepted for the exhibit. A valid animal health certificate issued by a vet has to be submitted. The certificate has to verify that the animal is clinically healthy (plague, MXT vaccinations), and, that it comes from a location where there are no dangerous infections. Veterinary supervision will be provided at the exhibit.

The Exhibit Program is Mandatory for Breeders, and is as follows:

- **Friday, 18th November, 2016**, from 2 p. m. to 7 p. m. - RECEIVING ANIMALS



- **Friday, 18th November, 2016**, from 7 p. m. - JUDGING ANIMALS
- **Saturday, 19th November, 2016**, from 8 a. m. to 6 p. m. - EXHIBIT TOUR
- **Sunday, 20th November, 2016**, from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. - RETURNING EXHIBITED UNSOLD ANIMALS

- Rabbits' return finishes at noon (12 p. m.). **After 12 p. m., the exhibit organizers are not responsible for rabbits which have not been collected by then.**

Receiving and Returning Animals

Animals have to be delivered personally to the exhibit grounds by a breeder. Each animal crate must have a label with a cage number, which breeders will obtain from the exhibit organizer by email, an SMS message or post office mail. With prior approval of the guarantor, animals will be caged by exhibitors themselves. Upon returning animals, exhibitors shall report to a particular guarantor who will give them the animals. Animals will be weighed upon arrival during the registration. The Exhibit Committee is not responsible for possible losses or damages to crates that might occur during the exhibit.

Animals' Assessment

The public will be excluded while animals are assessed. Throughout the assessment process, access to the exhibit grounds will be allowed only to delegated evaluators, observing interns, guarantors of particular displays, and those on the Exhibit Committee.

Degrees Awarded

Pursuant to directives in force, and achieved scores, the degrees awarded to the exhibited rabbits are as follows:

Master of Central European Exhibit

Male Champion and Female Champion of Central European Exhibit

Honour Award

Uncollected awards will not be sent via the post office. In order to award a prize, there have to



be on display three collections of the same colour at least from two different countries.

Animals' Sale

From each collection, at least one rabbit has to be for sale. If the breeder does not indicate the rabbit for sale, the first rabbit from the collection will be for sale for the price 100.00 €. Animals sale will be done only through the Treasurer of the Club, Mr. Pieger. Animals for sale will be placed in the competition. Sale price has to be stated in the application form. In our catalogue, the owner's stated sale price will be raised 10% for the benefit of the Club.

The minimum sale price for a rabbit is 100.00 €, the maximum price is 250.00 € . Additional rabbits for sale can be sold only through the cashier's office. The seller will be told there what the rabbits' prices are. Payments will be rounded up to the nearest 0.50 cents. Animals for sale that are delivered to the exhibit without a pedigree will be sold in case there is an interest. **Breeders shall collect money for the sold animals directly at the exhibit from Mr. Pieger, the Club's Treasurer.**

Changes in the Conditions of the Exhibit

The Exhibit Committee reserves the right to change exhibit conditions in order to ensure a successful exhibit. The Exhibit Committee will also deal with and decide about cases or situations which are not mentioned in the Exhibit Conditions.
